• **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

- Upon a motion duly made by Mrs. Lake and seconded by Mr. Buennig, the minutes of the Advisory Committee meeting held on January 30th, at 4:00 p.m. were approved.

FOLLOW UP FROM LAST MEETING:

- Mr. Thurman addressed some of the items that were mentioned about the indoor pool locker rooms at the last meeting. Some of the items that are turning a greenish color are brass fixtures, and the brass is oxidizing due to the climate of the room creating a layer of 'tarnish' on the metal.
- Mr. Thurman announced to the group that the Park Board did vote to collaborate with the Left Turn Lane project based upon the additional income received after the houses are sold.

COMMITTEE MEMBERS COMMENTS:

- Mrs. Gernant had questions about the rental fees being charged to clubs that used the facility for their meetings. Mr. Thurman explained that because the different clubs and groups were not Park District programs, that they are required to pay the room rental fee so that the Park District would be covered for any liabilities.
- Mrs. Lake made a mention about the wood flooring in the Life Fitness Room being "dusty" on occasions. Many programs and exercises require laying on the floor and the dust can be noticed at this time. Also the dust can build up on the bottom of participant's shoes and make the floor slippery.
- Mrs. Lake was appreciative of the new weights that were purchased for the Life Fitness Room, but mentioned that the grips were too wide to fit on the current rack.
- Mr. Buennig mentioned that the Elliptical, 2nd from the end, appeared to still be broken. He was wondering if we were planning on getting some of these items fixed or if they needed to be removed.
- Mr. Buennig was curious if we had looked into leasing options for cardio and weight equipment.

NEWS FROM STAFF:

- Mr. Sigwalt mentioned to the group about the upcoming Recreation activities for the spring, which included the Easter Egg Hunt (April 9), Spring Break Camp (April 10 – 13), Free Swims Indoor Pool (afternoons April 10 – 13), and the Pitch Hit and Run (April 30).

- Mr. Heaton mentioned the possibility of bringing back a membership appreciation day to give something back to the members.
