APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

- Upon a motion duly made by Mrs. Gernant and seconded by Mrs. Clark, the minutes of the Advisory Committee meeting held on January 29th at 4:00 p.m. were approved.

FOLLOW-UP FROM LAST MEETING:

- Scott had brought a list to the last meeting of recently updated or repaired items throughout the building. The list was not 100% complete, so Scott had provided a updated list with all of the 2017 updated or repaired items to present to the Committee.

COMMITTEE MEMBERS COMMENTS:

- Mrs. Clark had mentioned an issue she had noticed with the weight rack in the back hallway between the Life Fitness Room and Cycle Room. She mentioned that some of the weights did not fit properly in the rack and that it causes some people to pinch their fingers when removing or replacing the weights.
 - Andrew mentioned that this had also be brought up in a recent meeting with the Land Fitness Instructors, and that solutions to this issue where being explored such as purchasing a new rack and finding replacement weights that fit properly into the rack.

NEWS FROM STAFF:

- Andy is meeting with the architect for the gym improvements on Thursday for the project this summer. The updates will include flooring, track surface and lighting. IF the budget allows we will review painting, windows along the track and large fans.

- The Parktoberfest Planning Committee will meet on Wednesday, April 11 at 6pm to discuss auction items, sponsorship, decorations and other pending items. The date of Parktoberfest is October 20.
- Hammond Henry Hospital Rehab Services Department will be taking over the Personal Training and some of the Group Fitness classes starting in April. This comes as the current contract with Midwest Muscle has come to an end and bids for the services were received and reviewed by the staff. In addition, HHH will also provide FREE educational sessions for the community and look to build other programs including nutrition consultations in the future.
- The Park District has submitted our application to review our State Distinguished Accreditation status. We will be provided a mentor to review and then the Committee will review all documents later this year. We were originally accredited in 2012. This accreditation is a review of standards set by the state association IAPD (Illinois Association of Park Districts). The areas of concentration are: Legal, General Management, Finance and Business Operations, Facilities and Parks, Personnel and Recreation Services.
- Staff is in the process of reviewing the Summer Activity Guide. The guide should be available the first week in May.


ADJOURNMENT
