APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

- Upon a motion duly made by Mrs. Gernant and seconded by Mr. Newkirk, the minutes of the Advisory Committee meeting held on March 26th at 4:00 p.m. were approved.

FOLLOW-UP FROM LAST MEETING:

- No items from the previous meeting needed following up.

COMMITTEE MEMBERS COMMENTS:

- Mr. Newkirk asked the group if the sand volleyball courts were ready for use.
 - Andy mentioned that he would be able to address that in his notes.
- A discussion was had among the group about the tennis / pickleball courts and how the school and city projects would affect our courts.
 - Andy mentioned to the group that we would most likely wait to see what direction the school and the Richmond Hill projects end up before we make any major changes or additions to our current courts.

NEWS FROM STAFF:

- Andy updated the group on the current progress of the Main Gym project which included information about the new floor to be installed on the basketball courts and the track, the upgrade to LED for the lights, new fans, and hopefully large windows for natural lighting. Andy also mentioned the progress of the grant for this project.

- Andy discussed the upcoming Aquatic Center hours with the group which included open swim hours, swim lessons, night swims, outdoor aquatic fitness class, and Splash Pad hours.
- Andy mentioned the updates that were being made to the Athletic Field which includes the renovation to the sand volleyball pit, the repairs to the cracks in the basketball court, and the free equipment/games to be used such as ping pong, bags, kickball, wiffleball, and other yard games.
- Andy reminded the group of the upcoming Parktoberfest on October 20th.
- Andy shared with the group that the Park District had installed two Garden Boxes on the east side of the campus. Day Camp is looking into using one for one of the summer projects.
- Andy discussed the progress at Anderson Park and the plans to expand on the sidewalk which runs through the park onto the newer side of the property and to install some new trees along that property.
- Andrew informed the group of the new agreement with HHH-Rehab to take over the roles of Personal Training and to instruct the High, Moderate and Low Intensity fitness classes.
- Andrew discussed the upcoming start of Day Camp and the plans and programs that are set for the group this summer. Participation numbers are looking extremely well with one more week until the start of camp.
- Andrew discussed with the group some of the upcoming Special Events with the group which includes the Movies in the Park series, events for Music Fest weekend and our visit to Giant Goose on July 21st.


ADJOURNMENT
