| Memo Re: | 2022 Park District Goals Summary |

Staff Goals were established by the 2016 Strategic Plan and the current needs of the Park District by the Community, Staff and Members. The goals are separated by department and added each year for personal and departmental growth outside of the Strategic Plan. Goals are reviewed by staff several times throughout the year and updated where necessary. There are occasions where a goal will be moved to the next year or removed from the list based on needs or changes within the District.

Administration and Finance Goals

- Start Accreditation Review process (2023 2028)
 - Prep work for Accreditation review implemented.
- Update Comprehensive Plan
 - Completed Comprehensive Master Plan internally
- Update ADA Plan
 - Completed in the spring of 2022 by Mark Trieglaff of ACT Services
- Board Review of Mission & Vision
 - The Board reviewed the Mission and Vision in February 2022.
- Review and updating of policies and procedures by Board and Staff
 - *Completed throughout 2022*
- Target Marketing
 - Senior/Active Adults, Volunteers, Youth Programs to Schools, Individual Program Sheets, Online flip brochure, more social media post (Motivation Mondays, Throw Back Thursdays)
- Create a quarterly full-time staff training plan
 - Trainings have been happening throughout the year in different areas including RecTrac, Aquatics and Cyber Security.
- Create one Park District Team Building Event for ALL staff and Board
 - We will coordinate an all-staff event in 2023 during the summer months.

- Continue to evaluate programs and complete budget worksheets for all programs
 - Continued plan / ongoing process
- Establish Core Programs and evaluate offerings based on Core Programs

- Investigate and run three new programs
